

Following (12)

(1 Thess.1:5)

For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake

Following (13)

(Acts 26) "*Paul, you are beside yourself! Much learning is driving you mad!*"

Following (14-15)

(Jn.3:16) *For God so love the world that - - -*

(Jn.15:13) "*Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.*"

(1Jn.4:10) *In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.*

(Rom.5:8) *But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*

(Jn.4:19) "*We love him because He first loved us*"

(Rom.3:23) *All have sinned & fall short of the glory of God.*

(Eph.2:1) *And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,*

(Gal.2:20) *"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.*

(1Pet.4) Peter talks about the old life.....BC...= a life of in lewdness, *lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries.* ⁴ *In regard to these, the old crowd think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you*

(Col.3:9) *We have put off the old man with his deeds.*

(Ps.32:1-2) *Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, Whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, And in whose spirit there is no deceit.*
